GETTING HERE

BY CAR:

If you are arriving by car, and using a sat nav (satellite navigation/GPS) is D12 F2V4. The Aspect Hotel Parkwest has its own private car park with four accessible parking spaces. We have a drop-off/pick-up point at the main entrance.

BY TAXI:

We use the Free Now for all taxi bookings in the Hotel, including wheelchair-accessible vehicles. Our Front Desk team will be happy to arrange any transport you require, provided it is booked in advance.

NEAREST AIRPORT:

GETTING HERE (CONT.)

BY TRAIN:

The Park West and Cherry Orchard train station is just 2 minutes' walk from the hotel and offer up to 25 daily services Pearse Station in Dublin City Centre and Heuston Station for onward travel.

You can also catch the Heuston train to Kildare train station and spend the day at the Kildare Village Outlets? Their free shuttle will pick you up directly from the train station!

Park West and Cherry Orchard station features step-free access to platforms, designated disabled parking spaces, and automated ticket barriers with wider gates. Passengers with disabilities or reduced mobility can request assistance for boarding trains, with 24-hour notice recommended to ensure staff are available.

All trains serving the station offer ramped access for wheelchair users.

GETTING HERE (CONT.)

BY BUS:

Dublin Bus is a cost-effective and speedy way to travel in Dublin, costing about €3.00 to reach Park West from the city using bus route 151 or the new 24-hour G1 bus route. The commute time is usually around 35 minutes to and from the city, depending on traffic. Travel on Dublin Bus requires exact fare in coins only, and they don't offer change onboard.

The [G1 Dublin Bus route](#) also runs from the city centre to just outside the Aspect Hotel Park West. This route is 24hrs and brings you to Wellington Quay. Route 151 is a high-frequency service that operates from Grangecastle to the Docklands Station (close to IFSC) on the QBC, via Nangor Road, Long Mile Road, Crumlin, Dolphins Barn, Christchurch & O'Connell Bridge.

All buses on this route offer level access for wheelchair users.

GENERAL OVERVIEW



ACCESSIBILITY FEATURES & DESCRIPTION

- Disability awareness/equality training is provided for staff
- There is 24-hour guest assistance available
- Personal or General Emergency Evacuation Plans are in place for disabled customers
- An interactive virtual tour, or a walk/wheel through film, is available either on the business website
- Free familiarisation visits are available. You are welcome to arrange a visit ahead of booking/visiting to familiarise yourself and/or others with the venue at no additional cost.
- Facilities are available for assistance dogs e.g. water bowls, toilet area, within the grounds of the venue or nearby.

GENERAL OVERVIEW



ACCESSIBILITY FEATURES & DESCRIPTION

- Large print information is available on-site.
- A designated accessible toilet designed for wheelchair users and others with visible and non-visible accessibility requirements is available within the main public areas.

THE ACCESSIBLE TOILET HAS AS A MINIMUM:

- Step-free access.
- A manoeuvring space of 1500mm x 1500mm.
- An outward-opening door, where possible, with a minimum width of 850mm (800mm in Ireland)
- A transfer space on at least one side of the toilet with a drop-down grab rail on the transfer side.
- Horizontal grab rail positioned on the wall adjacent to the toilet.
- An emergency assistance alarm within reach from the floor.

PARKING



PARKING: FEATURE AND DESCRIPTION

- Designated accessible parking bays are available within 40 metres of the main entrance or an alternative step-free entrance if applicable.
- There is a step-free route with a firm surface from the parking to the main entrance or an alternative step-free entrance.

ENTRANCES



STEP-FREE ENTRANCE:

There is step-free access at the main entrance or an alternative entrance.

AUTOMATIC DOOR AT ACCESSIBLE ENTRANCE:

An automatic door is available at the main entrance or an alternative step-free entrance that opens on approach and/or by a push-button.

ACCESS TO PUBLIC AREAS

FEATURE AND DESCRIPTION



STEP-FREE ACCESS TO ALL OR MOST AREAS

There is step-free access to all or most areas. This may include access by ramp or lift. As a minimum, there is step-free access to an accessible toilet and at least one food and beverage outlet, where available.

LIFT

Lift /Elevator

Door width: 80 cm

Internal width and depth: 110 cm x 140 cm

Includes voice announcements, raised braille numbers on buttons, and visual indicators for easy access.

Service Dogs Welcome: Guide dogs/service dogs are warmly welcomed.

Family Amenities: Baby changing facilities are available.

Dining Area Access: Level or ramped access ensures all guests can enjoy our dining facilities.





There is at least one wheelchair-accessible bedroom to accommodate wheelchair users and others with mobility impairments.

WHEELCHAIR-ACCESSIBLE BATHROOM WITH ROLL-IN SHOWER

There is at least one wheelchair-accessible bathroom with a level floor, including a roll-in shower.

WE HAVE 12 ACCESSIBLE ROOMS IN THE HOTEL, 2 ROOMS ON EACH FLOOR

Each of our 12 accessible bedrooms includes an en-suite bathroom specifically designed for ease of use, with a fully accessible wet room, a waterproofed bathroom designed for easy access, safety, and convenience. suitable for guests with mobility needs.

Our Wet room is a fully waterproofed bathroom designed for easy access, safety, and convenience. It's especially suitable for guests with mobility needs.

LEVEL-ACCESS (WALK-IN) SHOWER

- No step or shower tray
- Flush floor design for wheelchair access
- Non-slip flooring
- Adjustable or handheld shower head

SHOWER SEAT

- Fold-down or fixed seat
- Allows guests to sit comfortably while showering

GRAB RAILS & SUPPORT BARS

- Positioned near the shower and toilet
- Provide stability and extra support

ACCESSIBLE TOILETS



ACCESSIBLE TOILET

- Slightly raised height for easier transfer
- Grab rails on one or both sides

ACCESSIBLE SINK

- Open space underneath for wheelchair access
- Lever-style taps for easier use

ACCESSIBLE TOILETS



FULL WATERPROOFING & DRAINAGE

- Entire floor is tanked (waterproofed)
- Slight gradient toward a floor drain
- Easy to clean and maintain
- Bathroom Door Width: 92 cm.
- Toilet Height: 47 cm.
- Emergency call cord/button for assistance.
- Clear space under the sink for wheelchair users.
- Lower mirror height for convenience.
- Lever tap handles make operating the sink simple.

ACCESSIBLE FEATURES



- Bedroom door width of 100.58 cm.
- Spyhole positioned at a lower height for ease of use.
- Convenient light switches and electrical sockets reachable from the bed.
- TV remote at an accessible height.
- Wardrobe and Storage:
 - Lower hanging rail inside the wardrobe.
- Emergency Features:
 - Flashing beacon visual fire alarm.
- Space for Movement:
 - The widest side of the bed is 111 cm.
- Bed Height and Design:
 - Mattress height from floor to top is 58 cm.
 - Under-bed clearance is 16 cm for compatibility with lifting devices.
